PROGRAMS

ALTERNATIVE PAYMENT PROGRAM

The Alternative Payment Program (AP) provides free or reduced cost child care throughout San Diego County to income eligible families. Child care assistance is provided for children from birth through 12 years of age in the child care location of the parent's choice. The AP program allows eligible parents to choose the type of care they feel best meets the needs of their family. Parents may select a licensed child care center, a licensed family child care home, a before/after school program, a legally license-exempt provider such as a relative (i.e. grandparent, aunt or uncle) or a friend or neighbor.

PRESCHOOL PROGRAM

CDA's educational preschool programs provide high quality and enriched learning experiences for the children in our care. High quality early education experiences leave long lasting impressions and they set the stage for a child's attitude towards school and learning. We value each child's learning and work closely with the school districts to ensure children have the necessary skills to be successful as they enter Kindergarten.

Our staff is highly qualified and is responsible for expanding the curriculum in the classroom through open ended questions, supplying hands-on materials, and by providing information and guidance to enhance learning. Our staff will develop and plan for a curriculum that is connected to each individual child's learning style and provide activities that build skills in language, math, science, and literacy. We embrace self initiated learning by allowing a child to freely explore and investigate within the environment of our program.

Our preschool program serves children 3 years through 5 years of age (from 18 months at our Eastlake location). Tuition assistance is available for income eligible families.

We encourage you to visit one of our centers and discover for yourself the enriched learning environment that we offer where each individual child is respected for their unique abilities and talents.
